Registration

Overnight Camp includes: accommodations, all meals while on campus, educational activities, field trips and entertainment, and 24 hr supervision by camp counsellors. There is also a day camp available. Students in this camp will not be staying overnight, but will attend camp Monday to Friday 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. They will partake in scheduled day activities with the overnight campers. Campers enrolled in the day camp will be responsible for their own lunch (and/or dinner if staying for evening activities) every day. However, meals are available for purchase.

Day Camper Meals

Payment Schedule

A 50% deposit must be provided at the time of registration. Cancellations one month prior to the start of camp will be entitled to a full refund less a \$35.00 administration fee. After this date, no refunds will be provided. The final 50% must be received one month prior to the start of camp at 4 pm (EST). Camper packages will be sent out 2 weeks prior to the start of camp.

Bursaries

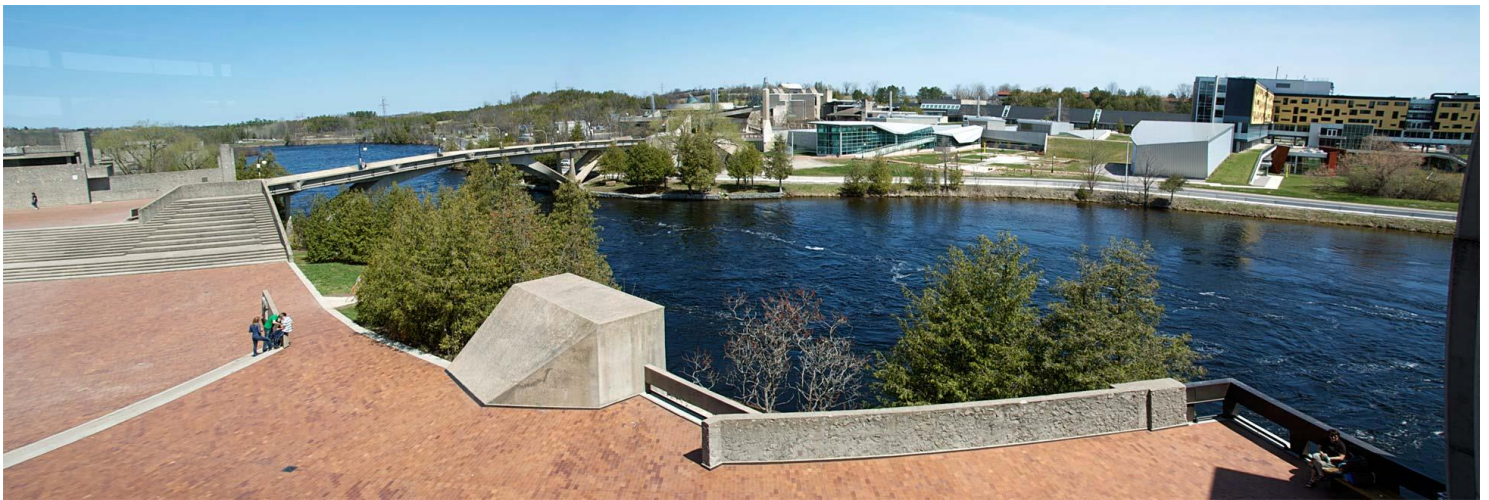
